Update Long QT Syndrome & Sports

Amsterdam, 01 August 2019

In this project of the ERN GUARD-Heart, healthcare professionals are invited to seek advice for their patients with long QT syndrome (LQTS) with regard to participation in sports. Healthcare professionals can do this by entering their patients with LQTS diagnosis who (wish to) participate in sports into the Clinical Patient Management System (CPMS)* and invite members of an advisory panel to provide recommendations.

Current members of the ERN GUARD-Heart advisory panel for this project are: Elijah Behr, Lia Crotti, Antoine Leenhardt, Anita Hiippala, Pier Lambiase, Jacob Tfelt-Hansen, and Arthur Wilde.

For each patient entered into the CPMS, the referring physician should upload at least a 12-lead ECG at baseline (and preferably during an exercise test). In addition, the referring physician is requested to fill in the digital Case Report Form (CRF) and upload it in CPMS. This CRF is also available for download on our ERN website (see link): Enrolment of patients in CPMS can start from now, the advisory panel will start their work on 1 September.



Educational videos by ERN GUARD-Heart experts

ERN GUARD-Heart has started to produce online educational videos for healthcare professionals who wish to gain more detailed knowledge on rare cardiac diseases & different aspects of multidisciplinary management of these diseases, e.g., next-generation sequencing, sports, pregnancy. The first two educational videos are now available on the official ERN website (see link). The management office is currently creating a list of topics and candidate speakers. Next, candidate speakers will be asked whether they are willing to participate. The videos will be produced & disseminated by the management office.

Upcoming call for European centers to join existing ERNs Brussels, 24 June 2019


The European Commission is currently preparing a second call for full members to join existing ERNs. The call is expected to be opened in September. ERN GUARD-Heart will be extended with two additional thematic areas: congenital heart disease and 'other rare heart diseases'. Each application will undergo and eligibility check by the EU and assessments by an independent assessment body and the specific ERN the candidate center wishes to join. It is expected that the assessment procedure & possible approval will be finalized at the end of 2020. Details are available on the European Commission website (see link). •
