

ERN GUARD-Heart Submits Feedback to EU Cardiovascular Health Plan

Amsterdam, 25-09-2025

ERN Guard-Heart has officially submitted feedback to the EU Cardiovascular Health Plan (Initiative 14755), a strategic initiative by the European Commission aimed at improving cardiovascular health across Europe. The plan addresses prevention, early detection, treatment, and rehabilitation of cardiovascular diseases — the leading cause of death and disability in the EU — and encourages stakeholder input to shape inclusive and effective policies.

ERN Guard-Heart calls for the explicit inclusion of rare cardiovascular diseases in the Plan. These conditions — such as inherited arrhythmias, cardiomyopathies, and congenital heart defects — are life-threatening and require specialized expertise and care.

Recommendations include:

- Dedicated recognition and funding for rare cardiac diseases.
- Integration of ERN expertise, including digital tools like CPMS and ERN Registries.
- Equitable access to specialized care across all Member States. Including rare diseases ensures the Plan addresses all patient needs and fosters innovation in care and research.

ERDERA's Networking Support Scheme

Luxembourgh, 7-2025

The European Commission's ERDERA Networking Support Scheme is a funding initiative designed to foster collaboration and knowledge exchange on rare diseases and rare cancers across Europe.

This continuously open call invites proposals from researchers, clinicians, patient advocates, and research managers. Eligible events must involve participants from at least three ERDERA countries and focus on rare disease or rare cancer research. Meetings can be held in person or in hybrid formats to maximise accessibility.

Applicants may request up to €30,000 per event to cover costs such as travel, meeting logistics, and digital platforms. The first assessment round will follow the 7 October 2025 deadline, with new rounds every six months until April 2029 or until the budget is fully allocated.
